#### HARVEST

Hand-harvested - April 14th, 2014

#### APPELLATION

Las Compuertas  
(Luján de Cuyo - Mendoza)

#### VINEYARD

Touza Vineyard. 3.444 feet Young vineyard, cane pruned, traditional furrow irrigation. Well-developed radical system. This wine comes from 8 year old vines.

#### SOIL

Well-drained Well-drained sandy-loam soils with scattered pebbles in the upper layers.

#### GROWING SEASON

The grape cycle started beforehand with early bud breaks as a result of the dry and warm spring. The growing season continued to evolve well. Special care and management in the vineyard helped to overcome the impact of unusual rainfalls reported during mid-December up to late March. Despite the predictable delays in sugar accumulation, the grapes achieved full physiological maturity, and harvest took place slightly later than normal. Yield is of 3.32 tons per acre.

#### AGING & BOTTLING

Aging for 17 months in new French oak (60%) and new American oak (5%) in combination with second use oak (35%). Bottled in November 2015. Unfined and unfiltered.

#### TASTING NOTES

Fleshy and robust malbec. It exhibits a great red color and presents aromas of wild herbs and flowers, ripe red fruit and subtle notes of spices and dark chocolate. A rich wine with a full mouthfeel and a persistent finish.
