Growing season

The 2023 season stood out for the excellent quality of the grapes in terms of health and balanced ripeness. Various climatic factors occurred during the cycle, including frost, hail, drought, and high temperatures, resulting in the lowest yield harvest since 1960 in Mendoza.

Vineyards

- Appellation: Mendoza
 - 77% Luján de Cuyo
 - 23% Valle de Uco
- Altitude: between 850-1400 m (2,780 - 4,800 ft).
- Soil: Alluvial. Low in organic matter, well-drained, with a high presence of rocks and gravel.

Winemaking

- Hand-harvest with shears, 3/22 to 4/26
- Manual selection of bunches
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% malolactic fermentation
- 9% aged in new French oak, 12 months
- Bottled unfined

Tasting notes

Deep red color, ruby tones. Aromas of cherries, red fruit, roasted pepper and black pepper. On the palate it is pure, rounded, balanced with long finish.
