CHARDONNAY 2023

Growing season

The 2023 season stood out for the excellent quality of the grapes in terms of health and balanced ripeness. Various climatic factors occurred during the cycle, including frost, hail, drought, and high temperatures, resulting in the lowest yield harvest since 1960 in Mendoza.

Vineyards

- Appellation: Villa Bastías, Tupungato - Valle de Uco
- Rows selection from blocks A5, A6 y A7
- Altitude: 1.150 m (3,772 ft)
- Soil: Alluvial. Characterized by a coarse sandy-loam texture, where rocks appear at varying depths, creating significant variation within the vineyard.
- Vineyard planted: 1995

Winemaking

- Hand-harvest at night with shears, 2/24
- Manual selection of bunches
- Fermentation in foudre (2500lts) of French oak
- 100% malolactic fermentation
- Aged in French oak barrels and foudre, 25% new, 10 months
- Bottled unfined, December 2023

Tasting notes

Presenting a yellow-pale hue with subtle green undertones, with aromas of anise, delicate green tea, and hints of floral notes. It reveals an expressive character, showcasing a notable mineral essence. Its intensity on the palate is remarkable, offering layers and complexity.
